Competition Format

[Preliminary Round]

Men

In the preliminary round, 12 countries are divided into three groups and play a round-robin tournament. The top two teams from each group, along with the two best third-place teams from the groups, advance to the knockout stage, totaling eight teams.

Women

In the preliminary round, 11 countries are divided into three groups and play a round-robin tournament. A total of eight teams, excluding the bottom team from each group, advance to the knockout stage.

[Knockout Stage]

The draw will be held after the competition concludes on Thursday, November 20th to determine the tournament bracket.

The technical meeting will be held on the following date in Gymnasium 1 on the first basement floor.



Based on hearing test regulations, athletes participating in the 2025 Summer Deaflympics are strictly prohibited from using hearing aids or cochlear implants during competition.


•Competition court (FOP), including team bench areas and official table areas **The restricted area is defined as the yellow-shaded zone below.

At the Tokyo 2025 Deaflympics, LED lights will be installed on the basketball goal posts and the Technical Officials' table to visually signal the referee's whistle.





(Bus Stop ①)




(Bus Stop ②)

National Olympics Memorial Youth Center — Sports Building (3-1 Yoyogi Kamizono-cho, Shibuya-ku, Tokyo)







Transportation Services

You may only use the facility for your team's games and practices. You cannot change the time or destination for personal reasons.

4. OTHER INFORMATION

How to Identify International Sign Interpreters

Several sign language interpreters will be present at the venue and will be wearing dark navy staff uniforms.

These interpreters include both International Sign interpreters and Japanese Sign Language interpreters. International Sign interpreters can be identified by a green sticker labeled "IS" on their uniform.

Please be advised that some volunteers wearing pink uniforms may also display an "IS" sticker; however, their ability to provide assistance may be limited to basic expressions.



ID Card

•	ID cards will be issued at Deaf Square. They will not be issued at the venue.
	ID cards are personal and non-transferable. Please carry them with you at alltimes within the venue zones.
	Additionally, your ID card is required when boarding buses to each competition venue, so be sure to carry it with you.
	If your ID card is damaged or lost, contact the main tournament office immediately. After that, the cardholder must personally visit the ID Center (Deaf Square) to complete the reissuance procedure.
