## Competition format

In the bowling competition at the Tokyo 2025 Deaflympics, in round 1, each player or team will bowl six games and compete for the total number of points scored. Round 2 will be a round-robin tournament, with the winners competing based on points won. The semi-finals and finals will be tournaments where the first player to win two games wins. The two players or teams who lose in the semi-finals will receive the bronze medal.

#### Access

• **From Shinjuku Station:**

Seibu Shinjuku Line “Seibu-Shinjuku Station” → “Kodaira” → Seibu Haijima Line “Higashi-Yamatoshi Station”

• **From Tachikawa Station (by train):**

Tama Monorail “Tachikawa-Minami Station” or “Tachikawa-Kita Station” → “Tamagawa-Josui” → Seibu Haijima Line “Higashi-Yamatoshi Station”

• **From Tachikawa Station (by bus):**

Tachikawa Station North Exit (Seibu Bus bound for “Nangai” or “Higashi-Yamatoshi Station”) → Seibu Bus “Higashi-Yamatoshi Station”

The bowling competition of the TOKYO 2025 Deaflympics will be held at Higashiyamato Grand Bowl.

The competition venue, Higashiyamato Grand Bowl, is located inside BIGBOX Higashiyamato, a three-story multi-purpose facility.

For the Deaflympics, only 1st floor areas ①-⑦ and the 2nd floor competition venue (Higashiyamato Grand Bowl) will be reserved for exclusive use.

All other areas, including the 3rd floor, will remain open to the public.

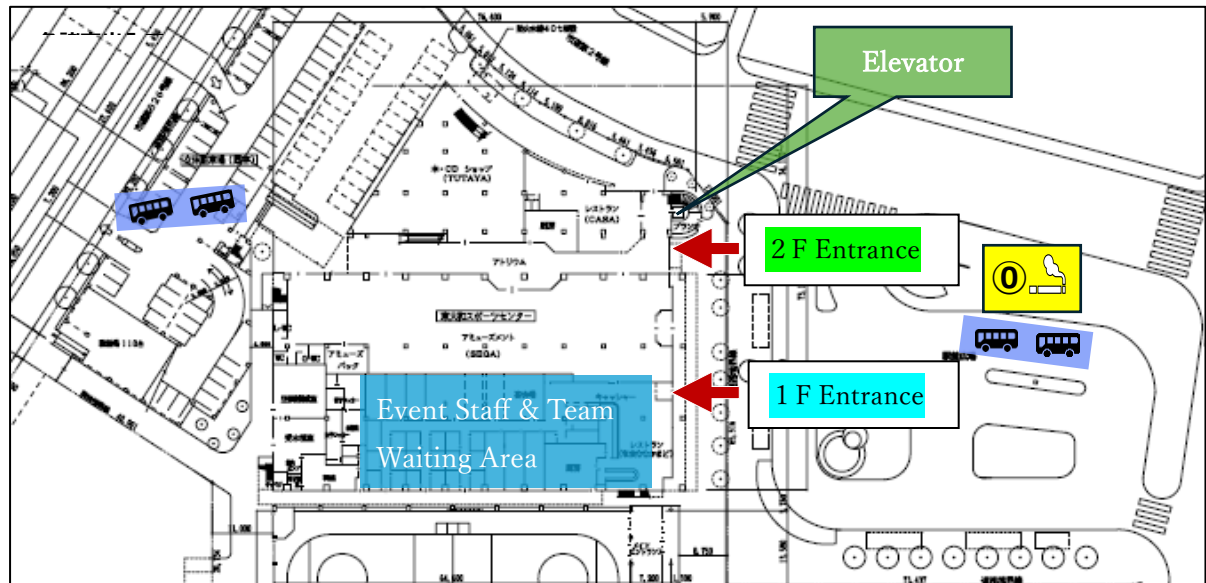

### ①Smoking area

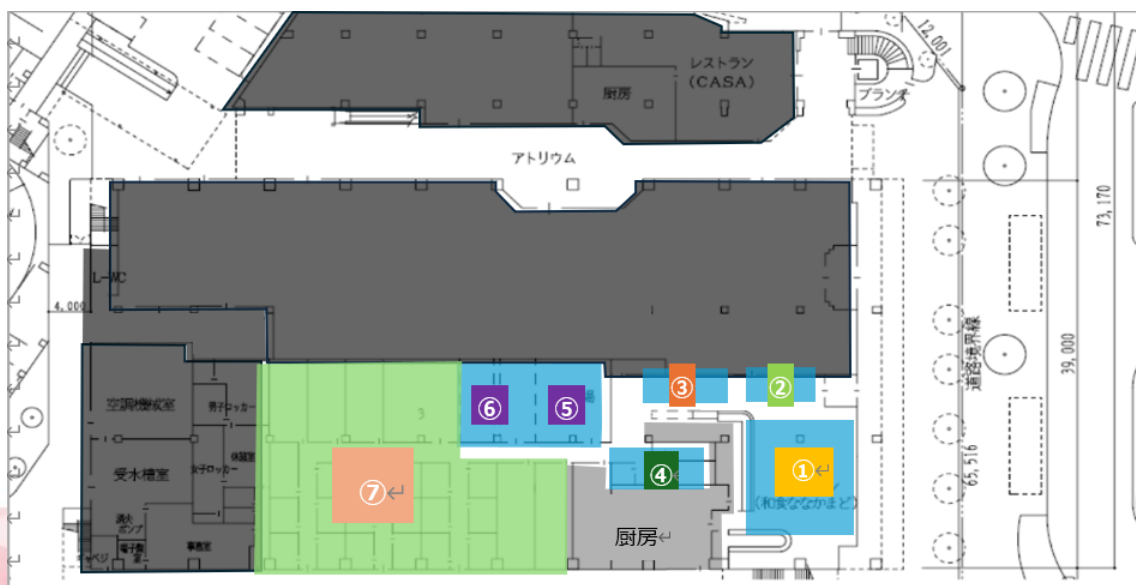

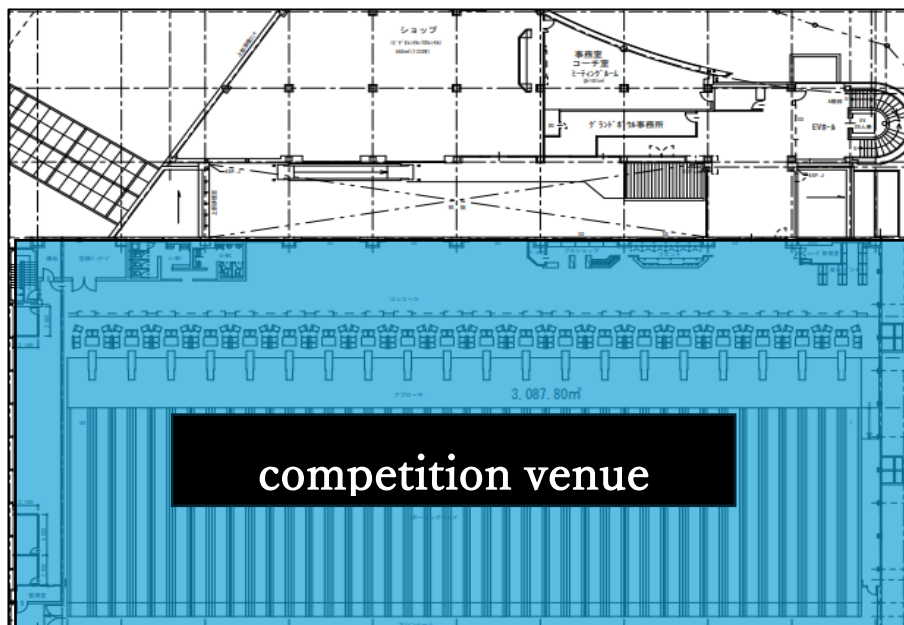

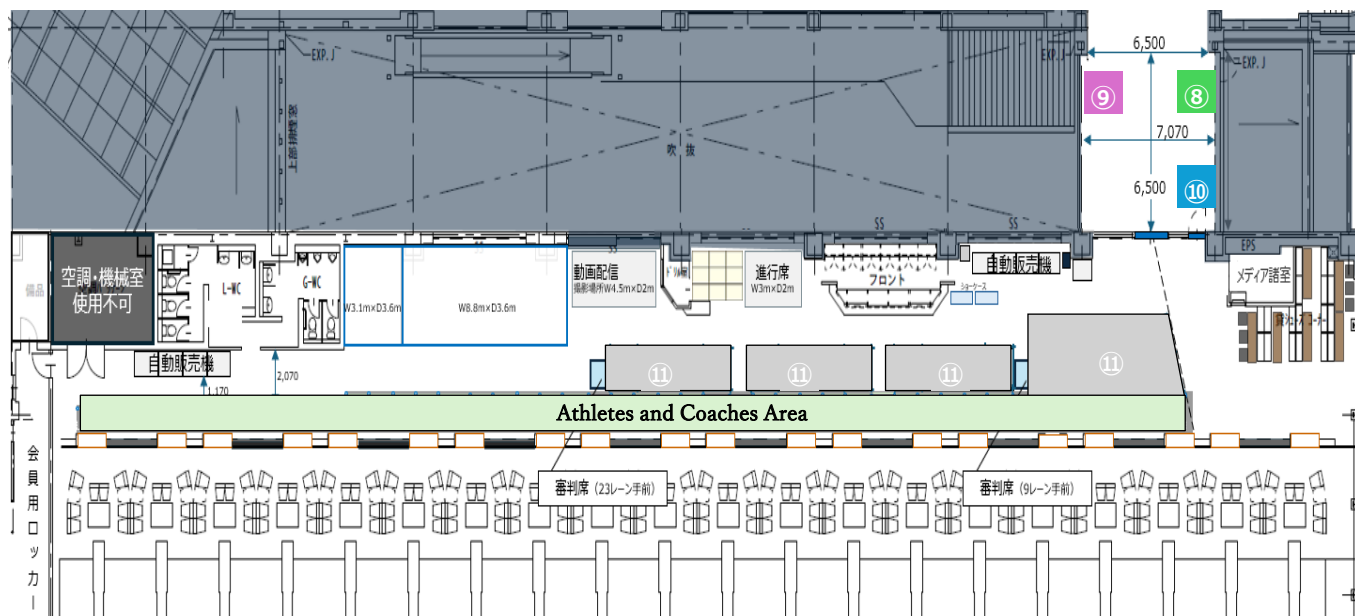

# Transportation Services

## – Regarding Transportation of Bowling Balls

The balls will be transported by truck, including the official training sessions on 15 and 16 November.

※Transportation method will vary depending on your accommodation:

- Hotel Emisia Tokyo Tachikawa: transportation by truck from the bus boarding area.  
Please bring your bowling ball bags at least 15 minutes before the bus departure time.
- Hotel Nikko Tachikawa: transportation in the same passenger car with the delegation's members, truck service not provided.
- Delegations staying at the National Olympics Memorial Youth Centre, Shinjuku and Shibuya areas: transportation by truck from the National Olympics Memorial Youth Centre. Please bring your bowling ball bags at least 30 minutes before the bus departure time.

※Delegations staying in the Shinjuku and Shibuya areas may deposit their baggage at the storage facility within the Olympic Centre when collecting their ID. A staff member will guide you to the storage facility. Athletes using this service are kindly requested to collect their bowling ball bags on the official training day.

※Please note that there is a limit to the number of bowling ball bags that can be loaded onto the truck. As loading will be on a first-come, first-served basis, please bring your bowling ball bags as early as possible.

Any bowling ball bags that cannot be loaded onto the truck, or those brought after the truck has departed, will be transported in the luggage compartment of the bus you will be travelling on.

※Regarding transportation of bowling ball bags on the return journey, arrangements will be made once the number of participants per event has been finalized. Details will be announced separately on the dedicated delegation website.

## - Team transport services

Please refer to the “Transportation Service” page on the delegation website ([Transportation Service | TOKYO 2025 DEAFLYMPICS - Games Information -](#)) for the latest transportation plan. The bus timetable will be published on this website.

※Please arrive at the bus boarding area with enough time to avoid missing your bus.

※Outbound and return buses may not necessarily be the same. Please make sure not to leave any personal belongings on the bus.

※You must present your ID card when boarding the bus.

※Transportation buses will operate according to the competition schedule.

As capacity is limited, please board a bus that fits your competition schedule.

You may not be able to board a bus that departs at times other than your competition time.

※If you are using public transportation, please check the access information on [the venue's official website](#) ([Higashiyamato Grand bowl | TOKYO 2025 DEAFLYMPICS - Games Information -](#)).

※Transportation to the competition venue for delegations staying at Nikko Tachikawa Hotel will be carried out using passenger cars.

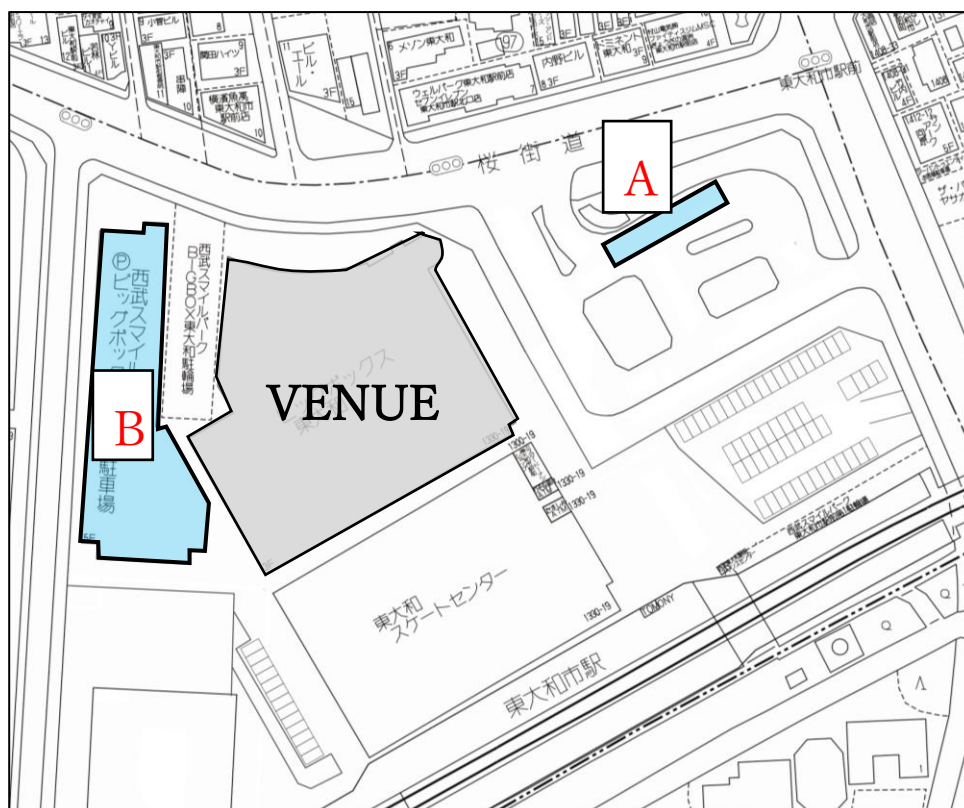

## Venue service

### – Food and beverage (MAP No1)

Water, energy bars, bread, and other light snacks will be available in the players' waiting room, but meals will not be provided. Please bring your own if necessary. There are also many convenience stores and restaurants around the venue, so please use them as needed. Payment will be in Japanese yen. Acceptance of credit cards varies by store. We recommend bringing cash.

- The locations of convenience stores and other facilities near competition Venues can be found using the following QR codes.



- If you need to leave early in the morning and are unable to have breakfast at your hotel, you can eat free of charge at the Olympic Center.
- Lunch and dinner will be your responsibility. Those who have made an optional advance reservation can have lunch and dinner at the arranged location.
- Dinner can be had at the Olympic Center, and payment is required on site.
- For information on food and beverage services at the Games, please check the team page.

### – Sport Information Desk (SID) (MAP No2)

At the Sports Information Desk, you can check results, bus timetables, and make various inquiries. It is located across from the athletes' waiting room. The Sports Information Desk has trainee interpreters who can speak international sign language and some spoken English. Tablets are also available to assist with communication.

### – Interview Space (MAP No10)

The interview space where accredited media can interview athletes and coaches after the competition is located next to the athlete registration area.

## – International Sign

Several sign language interpreters will be present at the venue and will be wearing dark navy staff uniforms.

These interpreters include both International Sign interpreters and Japanese Sign Language interpreters. International Sign interpreters can be identified by a green sticker labeled “IS” on their uniform.

Please be advised that some volunteers wearing pink uniforms may also display an “IS” sticker; however, their ability to assist may be limited to basic expressions.

# Precautions at the venue

## – About spectators

For bowling competitions, spectator areas (Map ⑪) and the number of people allowed will be designated. Please watch from this area (Map ⑪). Spectators must check in at the spectator reception (Map ⑨). However, admission will be restricted if the venue is full.

\*For players on match days, please board the bus that matches your competition schedule. You may not be able to board the bus if it is at a time other than your competition time.

## – About ID cards

- All teams will be required to show their ID cards when entering the venue.
- ID cards will be issued at Deaf Square. They will not be issued at the venue.
- ID cards are personal and non-transferable, and must be carried with you at all times within the venue zone.
- You will also need your ID card when boarding the bus to each competition venue, so be sure to carry it with you.
- If your ID card is damaged or lost, contact the tournament headquarters immediately. Afterwards, you must come to the ID Center (Deaf Square) in person to apply for a reissue.

## – Using the Escalator

There is an escalator at the venue, but using it with a bowling ball bag is prohibited, as it may cause damage to the escalator.

## – Using the Elevator

When moving between the 1st and 2nd floors while carrying a bowling ball bag, please use the elevator. However, please be considerate of users on the 3rd floor. When moving without a bowling ball bag, please use the stairs or escalator.

## – Smoking area

Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the competition venues and buildings, including waiting rooms for athletes and staff. Please use the public outdoor smoking areas (Map ⑩).

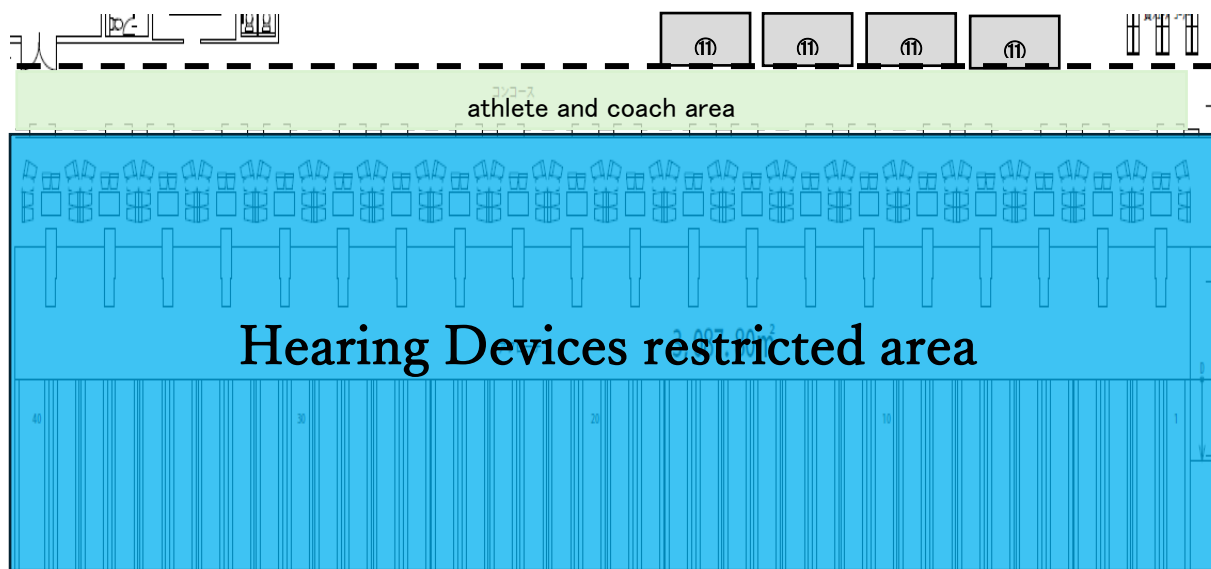
## Preparation for the competition start

## Hearing Devices restricted area

As per Audiogram Regulations, athletes participating in Summer Deaflympics 2025 are strictly prohibited from using any hearing aids or cochlear implant aids during competitions. This rule applies specifically to the restricted zone, which is defined as follows:

“Athletic bowling area, including the seating area and the bowling lanes”.

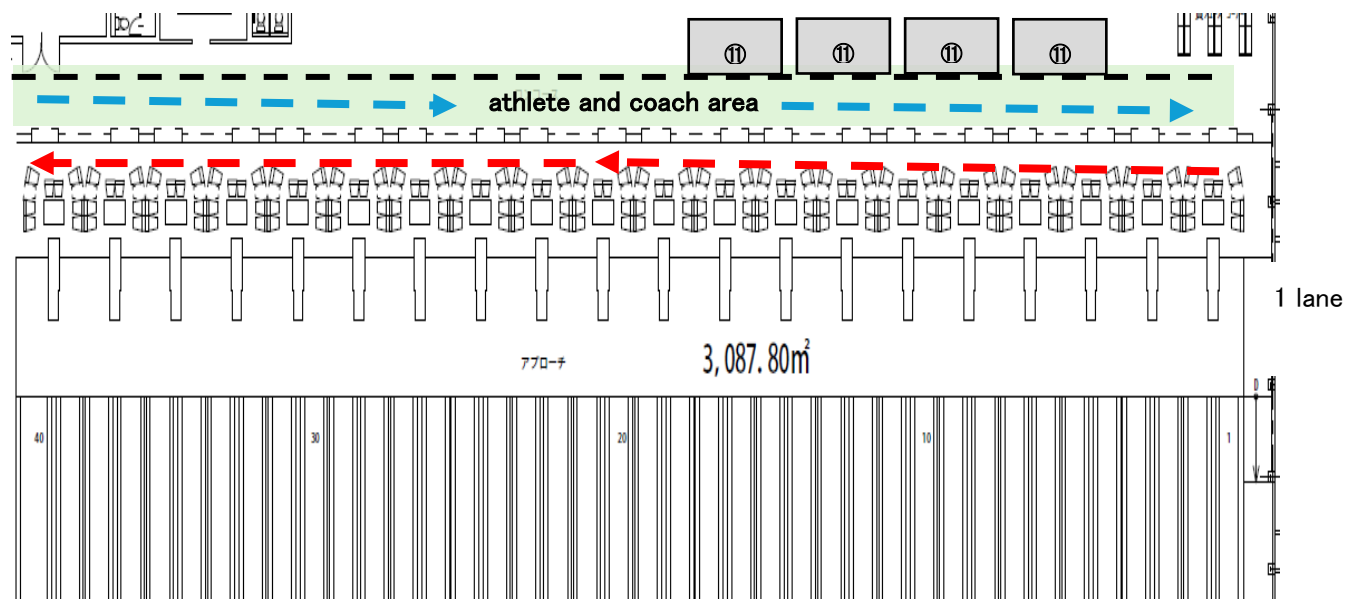

Even if your game on your lane has finished, please wait in your bowler's seat until the games on the other lanes have finished. Movement instructions will be displayed on the lane monitor.

When moving towards lane 40, please go through the bowling area, and when moving towards lane 1, please go through the athlete and coach area.

## Award Ceremony

An orientation for the award ceremony will be held after the finals of each event. Medalists should gather near lane 40. Please wear your country's uniform during the award ceremony.

Please also refrain from bringing items such as your country's flag, cameras, and smartphones to the ceremony. Award certificates will be distributed at Deaf Square the day after the ceremony.

## Competition results announcement

The results will be announced on the lane monitors and in the Team Waiting Area monitors approximately within 30 minutes of the end of the match.



## Bowling Ball Registration

Bowling Ball registration will take place at the Bowling Ball registration Area on the 1st floor (Map ③) after practice on official practice days. We will verify the bowling balls you bring against the bowling ball registration forms submitted in advance. If you are unable to submit the bowling ball registration form in advance due to unavoidable circumstances, please bring the bowling ball registration form with you.

## Technical meeting

The technical meeting will be held on the dates below in Deaflympics Square. Each participating NDSF may be represented by a maximum of two officials, of whom at least one must be deaf. The NDSF may also bring an interpreter if necessary.

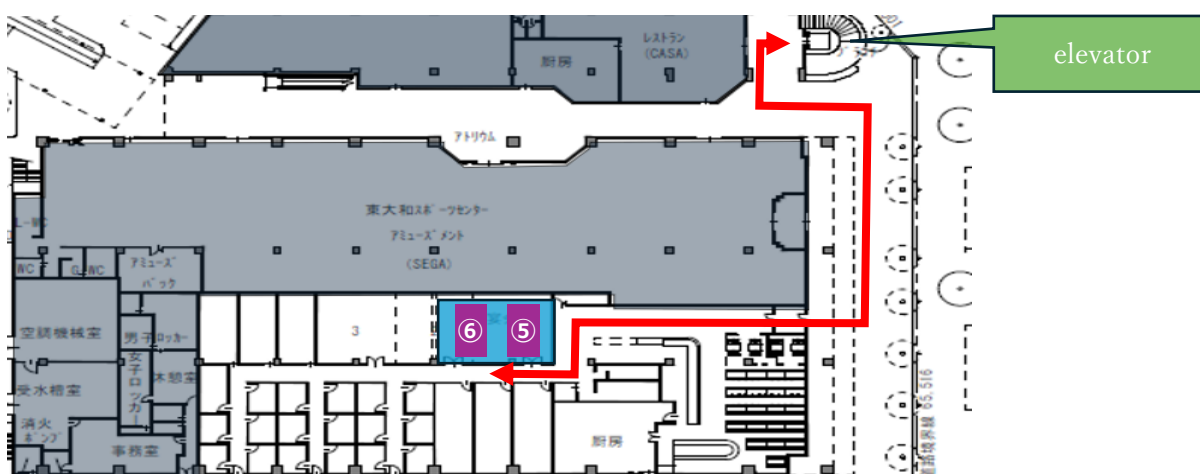

# Competition Equipment

## – Bowling balls

A maximum of 6 bowling balls per athlete is allowed to be brought into the competition venue. Bowling Balls registered on the official practice day can be stored in the ball storage area on the first floor (Map ⑤ and ⑥) during the competition period (15<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2025). Those who participated in the unofficial practice on the 14<sup>th</sup> November can leave their bowling balls in the bowling ball storage area before going home. If you wish, please bring your bowling balls to the area ② below after the unofficial practice. Athletes are responsible for travelling between the bowling ball storage area and the competition venue during the competition period. Taking bowling balls outside of the competition period is prohibited. We assume no responsibility for any damage to bowling balls during the competition period.

### – Support Items

Bowling tape, supporters, etc. can be purchased at the pro shop inside the venue.

Please pay in Japanese yen. Payment can be made by cash or credit card (American Express, Visa, Mastercard, JCB).

### – Back sheet

A back sheet with your athlete's number will be given to each athlete on the official practice day, and they should attach it to the back of their uniform during the competition.

## Precautions during competition

### – Food and beverage

Eating and drinking are prohibited in the bowlers' seats. Please hydrate at the back of the bowling area. Beverages must be placed on the counter at the back of the bowling area. Beverages must have a lid.

### – Touch panel

Players must not touch the touch panel on the bowler's seat. If a score correction is required, please wave the yellow flag on the table to appeal to the referee. The referee will make any score corrections.

### – Communication Board

The umpires generally do not speak sign language. When communicating with the umpire, please use the communication board located at the bowler's seat.
