



Important Notice for Delegations Participating in Cycling Events at TOKYO 2025 DEAFLYMPICS

Dear National Deaf Sports Federation (NDSF),

We would like to extend our heartfelt congratulations to all NDSFs participating in the TOKYO 2025 DEAFLYMPICS. In our efforts to create an environment that allows cycling athletes to fully focus on their competition, we are pleased to provide additional details regarding the transport and storage of bicycles during the Games. Additionally, please note that there have been changes to the previous information, and we kindly request that you also review the underlined section.

1. Transport of Bicycles Upon Arrival and Departure

The costs of transporting bicycles between the official airports and the competition venues upon arrival and departure during the Games are considered to be covered by the LOC. A survey will be conducted with each country's delegation to determine the number of bicycles they intend to bring. Regarding bicycle transport upon arrival and departure, it is anticipated that the LOC will transport unassembled bicycles by truck.

2. Bicycle Handover Schedule at the Competition Venue

Bicycles transported to the competition venue upon arrival will be available for handover to the delegations starting on Friday, 14th November 2025.

3. Bicycle Storage and Maintenance at the Competition Venue

Bicycle storage and maintenance will primarily take place at the competition venue, with a designated area allocated for this purpose.

4. Bicycle Storage, Maintenance, and Transport at the Hotel

Assembled bicycles may be stored in guest rooms, with one bicycle permitted per athlete.

However, maintenance of bicycles within the rooms is strictly prohibited.

Furthermore, the transport of bicycles between the hotel and the competition venue will be the responsibility of the delegations. Delegations must arrange their own vehicles for bicycle transport. Alternatively, upon request, our official travel agency, JTB Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "JTB"), can assist with arranging transport. Details regarding costs and payment methods will be provided to delegations requesting this service at a later date.



5. Self-arranged Vehicles (Rental Cars)

Delegations may arrange vehicles at their own expense to transport bicycles. In such cases, JTB can assist with booking the vehicles.

Note: When transporting assembled bicycles, delegations must prepare packaging materials, such as blankets, to ensure safe transport without causing any damage to the bicycles.

Please be aware that if any members of the delegation are driving a rental car, they must have an international driving permit that is valid in Japan. Furthermore, a Class C endorsement on the international driving permit is required to drive a 2-ton truck.
